1. Repairs update.

3. Broken cement repairs.

4. Winter letter.

\*Steve is currently working on this and is going to add the information regarding the xtra insurance homeowners will want to purchase to help offset any future assessments for repair.

5. Porch rails. 844 has had their porch railing removed due to having to replace front porch cement. Can it be left off and can others do it. (Is this structural? Must not be since there isn't one on 844. Being open looks a lot better. - if we were to leave it open for those that didn't want a flowerbed we could just extent

the cement and not have to worry about take care of people's flowerbeds.)

6. Update on HOA dues for 2023
